## The Deep End - The first Mission:

Jesus gave the disciples a share in his mission by sending them out ahead of him. It was a gesture of trust and confidence on his part, even though they did not fully understand his mission. Have you ever been surprised by the trust shown in you by others to speak or act on their behalf?

Jesus sent the disciples out two by two. Perhaps your experience gives you examples of value of having another with you when engaged in an important task. The apparently strange instructions given by Jesus were intended to counteract practices by bogus preachers who used preaching as a mask for money making. True disciples of Jesus focus on the mission and not on their own comforts. Is it your experience that vested interests can impede a task, whereas having the right motives make your mission more effective? The task of the disciples was to call people to repent. Who have been the people in your life who have called you to be more trusting in God? To whom have you given this call? (Paulo Coelho said "A boat is safe in the harbour, but this is not the purpose of the boat").

## July is Reek Month – Pilgrimage on Croagh Patrick:

The annual Reek Sunday Pilgrimage on Croagh Patrick will be going ahead this year in a much extended format from Thursday 1st to Saturday 31st July. The Masses (Wednesday - Saturday) will be limited to the numbers permitted for outdoor gatherings at that particular time, which apply to 200 people. Pilgrims are asked to plan their trip to Croagh Patrick as early as possible and keep in mind that mid-week is traditionally a quieter time to climb.
