## **Reflection:**

Peter invited Jesus into one of his most important and precious possessions, his boat. This was the means of his livelihood and gave him status among the others. Peter also allowed Jesus tell him where

to fish, handing over control of this boat and his own life to Jesus. In prayer, we invite Jesus into the most personal and important places of our lives. We also allow him to take possession of us, giving all that we can to him. From Peter's boat, he spoke to the crowds, from our lives he speaks to people today. Did Peter really like Jesus taking over his boat? The boat was one of a fisherman's most valued assets. It probably smelt of fish and maybe was not the best boat in Galilee. Jesus chose to get into Peter's boat to speak to the crowds. We take this as asking Peter to allow him into his life, and that very soon Peter's whole life would be for Jesus, as today his boat would be at Jesus's disposal. An adventure is about to unfold, an encounter that is radical and life changing.



Simon the fisherman, called by Jesus to go beyond his comfort zone, puts the boat of his life out into deep waters. His faith and trust is rewarded abundantly. From that moment forward his entire life is hooked on Jesus.
