Bishop Francis's Appointment: Last Wednesday week the announcement came that our own Bishop Francis is to become the new Archbishop of the Archdiocese of Tuam. While we welcome this news, we will also miss him from our diocese of Ardagh and Clonmacnois. Bishop Francis has been Bishop here in the diocese for eight years, and has been very helpful to all of us in so many different ways, but has been a fantastic shepherd to his priests and people. On behalf of the people of Ardagh and Moydow, may I wish Bishop Francis good health, happiness and fulfilment in his new role as Archbishop of the Archdiocese of Tuam. Personally, a sincere thanks to Bishop Francis for all his kindness and compassion during his time as Bishop of our diocese.

Feast of Christ the King: The feast today, and the gospel gives us an opportunity to reflect on different ways in which we, and others, exercise influence and leadership. Who are the people whose witness to truth has impressed you, either now or in the past? In what way have you been able to witness to truth?
